Re: Liquid Crystal Labels and Indicators

Liquid Crystal Labels and Indicators are non-electronic temperature indicators. Composition varies according to the range and type. They are printed laminates composed of self-adhesive films (with modified acrylic adhesives) polyester film, and various organic cholesterol esters.

As part of our on-going commitment in ensuring that we comply with all legislative requirements, we have implemented the full requirements listed under the REACH Directive.

The chemicals present are, non-hazardous and comply with RoHS 3 (EU2015/863), WEE and Reach directives.

In terms of the complete SVHC list, as updated 16th January 2020, we are happy to confirm that all the named products supplied by LCR Hallcrest do not contain any chemicals as listed on SVHC.


