## IS YOUR WATER TOO HOT?

## **The Hot Water Gauge**

- Insert the bottom of this card into a cup of hot water. (Run water for 3 to 5 minutes.)
- If a number appears and it is:
  GREEN that is the temperature of the water.
  BLUE-the temperature is more than that number.
  TAN the temperature is less than that number.
  RED 150+ the temperature is 150° or greater.
- 3. If no change occurs, the water temperature is under  $120^{\circ}$ .
- 4. For most uses 120° to 130° should be adequate. If yours is hotter, turn down your water heater thermostat to save money, and lessen the danger of tap water scalds.
