**REACH/RoHs REGULATIONS** 

Re: Liquid Crystal Labels and Indicators

Liquid Crystal Labels and Indicators are non-electronic temperature indicators. Composition varies according to the range and type. They are printed laminates composed of self-adhesive films (with modified acrylic adhesives) polyester film, and various organic cholesterol esters.

The chemicals are proprietary, non-hazardous and comply with RoHs 3, WEE and REACH directives.

As part of our on-going commitment in ensuring that we comply with the entire legislative requirement, we have implemented the full requirements listed under the REACH Directive and the substances listed under SVHC.

Liquid Crystal temperature indicating strips comply without exemption with REACH Annex XVII and Annex XIV.

In terms of the complete SVHC list, as updated June 2018, we are happy to confirm that all the named products supplied by LCR Hallcrest do not contain any internally added chemical as listed on the SVHC. Our suppliers of raw materials all confirm SVHC chemicals are not used in the manufacture of their products.
