

IS YOUR WATER TOO HOT?

The Hot Water Gauge

1. Insert the bottom of this card into a cup of hot water. (Run water for 3 to 5 minutes.)
2. If a number appears and it is:
GREEN - that is the temperature of the water.
BLUE - the temperature is more than that number.
TAN - the temperature is less than that number.
RED 150+ the temperature is 150° or greater.
3. If no change occurs, the water temperature is under 120°.
4. For most uses 120° to 130° should be adequate.
If yours is hotter, turn down your water heater thermostat to save money, and lessen the danger of tap water scalds.
